DISMISSAL DRIVE THRU Front Entrance (S.W. 78th Place) NORTHWEST GATE "B"

IMPORTANT: Parents choosing the "Drive-Thru" option MUST REMAIN in their car while on S.W. 78th Place.

All students will assemble by Room 003 until their name is called.

<u>DISMISSAL BUS – SOUTH SIDE GATE (S.W. 2nd Street)</u> See Map Location "C"

- Private buses will park on the south side of the school (on S.W. 2nd Street).
- Bus students in grades Pre-K-1will assemble in the cafeteria.
- Bus students in grades 2-5 will line up under the P.E. Shed.
